**NOTICE OF APPEAL**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Defendant Dr. James H. Fetzer appeals to the Court of Appeals, District IV, from the Decision and Order Sanctioning James Fetzer Under WIS. STAT. § 802.05 dated October 4, 2024, which extends the deprivation of Defendant's Constitutional Rights under Color of Law in violation of 18 USC § 241 and § 242 by Judge Remington in collusion with Pozner's attorneys. Exposing Extrinsic Fraud and Fraud upon the Court may be undertaken at any time in any court under *United States v Throckmorton*, 98 U. S. 61 (1878). Defendant cannot have improperly published a child's statutorily-protected information—a passport number—because (a) the passport is counterfeit (as Defendant had previously proven) and (b) the person thereby named ("Noah Pozner") is a fiction created out of photographs of his (purported) half-brother, Michael Vabner, who is not a child, proof of which Defendant has previously submitted.

The Court has refused to admit Defendant's proofs as evidence lest there be disputed facts that require a jury to resolve, just as this Court has done with every other proof Defendant has submitted, including the reports of forensic document experts that the death certificate for which Defendant has been sued for declaring to be "fake" is fake. Defendant has sought (repeatedly) to

hold Judge Remington to account and reverse his finding of defamation, because Defendant's assertion (that the published death certificate was fake) was true. The only improper purpose here is Plaintiff's attempt to suppress proof of Defendant's innocence and Judge Remington's compliance in accommodating his attorneys in their ongoing efforts to seal and suppress proof of Fraud upon the Court based upon Extrinsic Fraud, which Defendant has copiously documented in his previous submissions, which Judge Remington has similarly treated with contempt in violation of the Wisconsin Rules of Civil Procedure. A true and correct copy of the said order Document 660 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by specific reference.
